On March 30, 2020, California Chief Justice Tani Cantil-Sakauye issued an order implementing temporary emergency measures as approved by the Judicial Council which clarified the calculation of the 60-day continuance of jury trials. On April 6, 2020, the Judicial Council of California approved 11 temporary emergency rules which included;

- setting bail statewide at \$0 for misdemeanors and lower-level felonies which is intended to safely reduce jail populations, and
- staying eviction and foreclosure proceedings.

Implementation of the statewide emergency bail must be done not later than 5:00 p.m. on April 13, 2020. Humboldt Superior Court has been actively working with justice partners implementing the new statewide emergency bail schedule since ordered by the Chief Justice on April 6, 2020.
