

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO.: 2020-009  
RE: MISDEMEANOR SETTLEMENT  
COURT REVIEW HEARINGS

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Court will vacate all review hearings scheduled in Misdemeanor Settlement Court (Court 8) beginning March 17, and until 90 days after the Governor declares that the State of Emergency related to the COVID-19 pandemic is lifted. These review hearings shall only be vacated if they are related to post-adjudication compliance with probation. The Court will not vacate domestic violence review hearings, and any domestic violence hearing shall be re-noticed.
