Ability-to-Pay Determinations and Adjustments

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING
DEPUTY CLERK TO MAKE ABILITY-TO-
PAY DETERMINATION

Pursuant to Government Code Section 68645.3, Humboldt Superior Court authorizes deputy clerks to make ability-to-pay determinations for infraction matters as follows:

1. Upon receipt of a request for an ability-to-pay determination wherein the applicant states they are receiving public benefits and they show proof of those benefits, individuals may be eligible for up to a 75% reduction of the total amount owed.

2. Upon receipt of a request for an ability-to-pay determination wherein the applicant does not receive public benefits, a 50% reduction of the total amount owed may be granted for individuals whose income is at or below 350% of the federal poverty level.

3. Deputy clerks are not authorized to deny a request for an ability-to-pay determination, but may reject the request if the applicant fails to provide sufficient information required to make a decision.
