ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REQUIRING
DAILY COVID-19 SCREENING FOR IN-
PERSON COURT APPEARANCES


ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO.: 2020-015

In consideration of the recent, unprecedented increase in positive cases of COVID-19 in this county and elsewhere, Humboldt Superior Court seeks to ensure that court users are not unduly or inadvertently exposed to COVID-19 infected individuals. All attorneys and all other individuals appearing in person for court hearings shall be required to complete a daily COVID-19 screening before being allowed into a courtroom. Anyone that does not complete and pass the required screening will not be allowed to remain on the second floor and will not be allowed in courtrooms.

If any individual believes some exception to this pandemic protocol would apply to them, they should submit a written request to the ADA (American Disabilities Act) Coordinator utilizing the Request for Accommodations by Persons with Disabilities and Response form located on the Court's website with the following link: <http://www.courts.ca.gov/documents/mc410.pdf?1607720205114> five court days prior to the scheduled appearance date. The request will be routed to the Presiding Judge for consideration.
